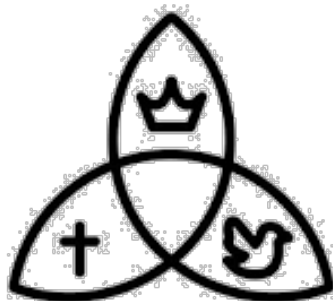

Acts 1:4-5 NIV

4 On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: “Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. 5 For **John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.**”

John 14:16-20 KJV

16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

18 I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

19 Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.

20 At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

Romans 8:9-11 NIV

9 You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. **And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ.** 10 But if Christ is in you, then even though your body is subject to death because of sin, the Spirit gives life because of righteousness. 11 And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you.

*(But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom **those who believe in Him should receive**; for the Holy Ghost was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.)*

John 3:1-8 NIV

Jesus Teaches Nicodemus

¹ Now **there was a Pharisee, a man named Nicodemus** who was a member of the Jewish ruling council. ² He came to Jesus at night and said, “Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the signs you are doing if God were not with him.”

³ Jesus replied, “Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again¹”

⁴ “How can someone be born when they are old?” Nicodemus asked. “Surely they cannot enter a second time into their mother’s womb to be born!”

⁵ Jesus answered, “Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. ⁶ **Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit^l gives birth to spirit.** ⁷ **You should not be surprised at my saying, ‘You must be born again.’** ⁸ The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit.”^l

FALSE TEACHING ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT

When You Receive It?

The Moment you are saved.

Romans 8:9-11 NIV

⁹ You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. **And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ.**

Can You Control It? YES!

1 Corinthians 14:31-33 NIV

*31 For you can all prophesy in turn so that everyone may be instructed and encouraged. 32 **The spirits of prophets are subject to the control of prophets.** 33 For God is not a God of disorder but of peace—as in all the congregations of the Lord’s people.*

1 Thessalonians 5:19 KJV

¹⁹ Quench not the Spirit.

Can You Lose The Holy Spirit? NO!

Ephesians 4:30-32 KJV

*And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby **ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.** Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: and be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.*

Do You Have To Speak In Tongues To Have The Holy Spirit? NO!

1 Corinthians 12:9-11

⁹ To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

*¹⁰ To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; **to another divers kinds of tongues;** to another the interpretation of tongues:*

¹¹ But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

Acts 2:1-17 KJV

¹ And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

² And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

³ And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

⁴ And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

⁵ And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

⁶ Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language.

⁷ And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans?

⁹ Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia,

¹⁰ Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes,

¹¹ Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.

¹² And they were all amazed, and were in doubt, saying one to another, What meaneth this?

¹³ Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine.

¹⁴ But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words:

¹⁵ For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day.

¹⁶ But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel;

¹⁷ And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:
