1 Timothy 3 KJV

This is a true saying, if a man **desire the office of a bishop**, he desireth a good work.

2 A bishop then **must be blameless**, the **husband of one wife**, **vigilant, sober**, of **good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach;**

3 Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous;

4 One that **ruleth well his own house**, having his **children in subjection** with all gravity;

5 (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?)

6 Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil.

7 Moreover he must **have a good report of them which are without**; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.

8 Likewise must the deacons **be grave, not doubletongued, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre**;

9 Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.

10 And let these also **first be proved**; then let them use the office of a deacon, being **found blameless**.

11 Even so must their **wives be grave**, **not slanderers**, **sober**, **faithful in all things**.

12 Let the deacons be the **husbands of one wife**, ruling their children and their own houses well.

13 For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus.
